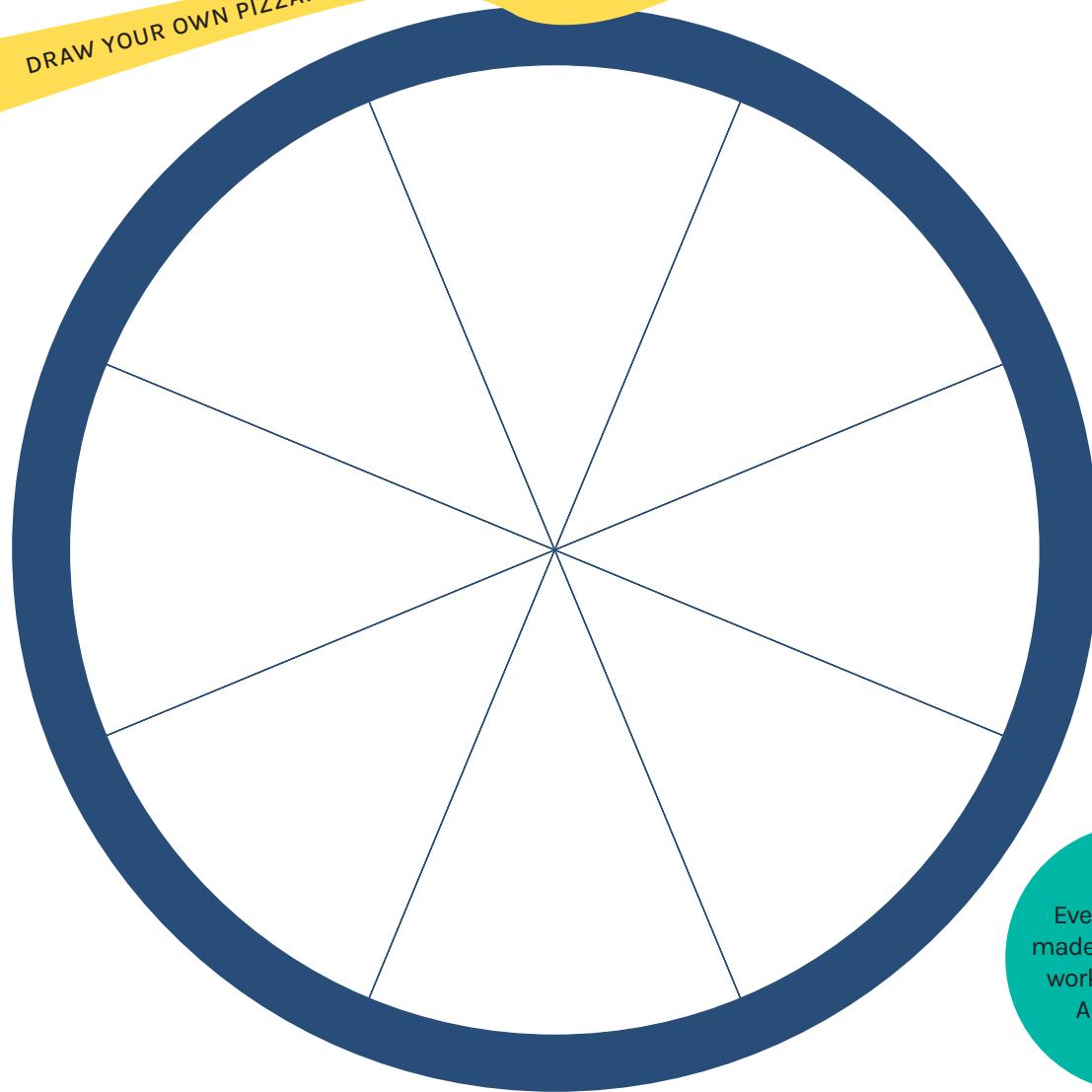

In our entrance area, there are 4 big clocks. Each clock shows a different time, and together they make a bigger picture. It's like a puzzle! This artwork is called The Warwick Dials by Richard Wentworth. They welcome you to 'Warwick Arts Centre time.'

Just outside, you'll see a huge sculpture called the White Koan by Liliane Lijn. It's 6 meters tall and spins around with lights. Some people say it used to be part of a rocket from a space mission!

We have lots of stairs at Warwick Arts Centre. Look for signs to the cinemas. How many stairs do you need to climb to get there? Can you find all the cinemas?

Follow the signs to the Music Centre. There, you'll find some funny-looking instruments. Can you make any sounds with them? This is our Musical Playground, and it's free for everyone to enjoy!
